The Ohio Scholarship Tax Credit provides dollar-for-dollar from your Ohio income tax for gifts up to \$750 for individuals and \$1,500 per couple made to a certified Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO).

All tax payers qualifying with an Ohio tax liability in any given year may designate a donation to go to scholarships for students attending any Christian school (including **Rhema Academy**) that participates in *Ohio Christian Education Network (OCENSGO)*.

Contributions may be made to **OCEN** any time of year. During the 2023-24 school year, **OCEN SGO** awarded a total of **\$1.6 million** in scholarships to **1,622 students**.

How to Claim the Scholarship Granting Organization Tax Credit for Rhema Academy

- 1. Donate to the Ohio Christian Educators Network Scholarship Fund

 Donate at https://ohiocen.org/ocen-sgo/donate/ or use the QR Code on the front

 Make sure you choose Rhema Academy
- 2. Print the form OCEN will send you after you donate you will need this to file this with your state income tax forms when you file your taxes.
- 3. Steps to use when filing your State Income Tax
 - a. Enter the amount you donated on Line 15 of the Schedule of Credits
 This is on Page 7 of the 2024 Ohio IT 1040 Form
 It is also called 2024 Schedule of Credits page 1 of 2
 - b. Your donation will be included on Line 35 and then again on Line 39. This total is then put on Line 9 (which is on page 2 of the Ohio IT 1040 Form).
 - c. Line 9 is then subtracted from Line 8 (This is the total tax you should have paid, based on your income), which gives you your new total tax liability on Line 10.

Pages 7-8 and Page 2 of the 2024 Ohio IT 1040 are attached to this form. This shows you exactly where to put your SGO Donation and how it will impact your overall state tax.
